
A New Enhancement was recently released for a New Global Search Menu, which should save a couple clicks when starting a new search.

1. New Global Search Menu:

Clicking "Search" in the global navigation bar at the top of every page will now open a menu of options, allowing you to select the type of search you'd like to run. Options include:

- Lease Listings
- Sale Listings
- Lease Comparables
- Sale Comparables
- All Properties


2. Search Mode Reminder

We're now starting to better differentiate "Property" searches from "Listings/Comps" searches. If you're searching for sale/lease listings or completed transactions, you often care about different things than if you're prospecting or doing a general building survey. We will be evolving the different kinds of searches separately over time, but to start, we've added an indicator to the top-left to remind you of which mode you're in currently.


The indicator to the left labeled "Listings/Comps"; are for the following selections:

- Lease Listings
- Sale Listings
- Lease Comparables
- Sale Comparables

If you clicked on the option: "All Properties" you'll notice it has a different indicator to the left labeled "Properties", see snapshot below.



3. Search View Menu:

We've recently changed this toggle to a menu to allow for more options over time. The current options are:

- Map View
- List View
- Grid View
- **Table View** (This new view is designed to feel like a spreadsheet, making it easier to browse and compare large amounts of data.)




Table View:

A few highlights on the Table View are as follows:

- We start with default columns depending on what you're searching, but you can customize those columns, adding/removing to ensure your view includes the data most relevant to you.
- Columns can also be resized, reordered, and pinned left/right.
- There are separate "Properties" and "Listings" modes controlled by a toggle at the top. When "Properties" is selected, each row will represent a building. When "Listings" is selected, each row will represent a particular space/suite that's available, with potentially multiple rows for buildings with multiple spaces.
- Future enhancements will include the ability to save your column configurations for future use, and an export feature that will allow you to download your results in a spreadsheet that matches what you see on the screen.
